

CENTER HIGHLIGHTS

1-minute walk from the Newmarket T Station and 2-minute bus ride from Andrew Square T Station, with a combined annual ridership of more than 4 million

Boston's most accessible center with proximity to all major roads, located at exit 18 off 93 - 204,335 vehicles per day

Population is expected to grow to 439,128 people within 3 miles of South Bay by 2028

758,061 day time population and 27,633 businesses within 3 miles

\$146,375 average household income within a 3 mile radius

10.6M annual trips with an average dwell time of 59 minutes
